THE RSV VACCINE IS NOW AVAILABLE!

WHAT TO KNOW

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) is a common respiratory virus that usually causes mild, cold-like symptoms.



People ages 60 and older **may** get the vaccine. Those over 75 years **should** get the vaccine.



RSV can be dangerous for older adults, leading to health complications. The vaccine protects you against severe cases of RSV.



The vaccine is available now. Protection should last through the winter season so don't delay.



The RSV vaccine is covered by Medicare Part D and most major insurance plans.
